DRESS CODE

Delegates are expected to wear Western formal attire on both days of the conference. They must be appropriately dressed for a formal setting.

- Delegates, regardless of gender, must wear suit trousers and a shirt/blouse (blazers and ties are optional, but recommended).
- Subdued colours are not a requirement; however, particularly loud or flashy colours are not in order.
- Blazers and suit jackets (if worn) should be on during formal debate, and buttons should be closed when a delegate takes the floor to speak.
- Shirts or blouses should have appropriate prints and necklines.
- A neat hairdo is a must.
- Please be advised that dresses, skirts, jeans, shorts, sleeveless tops, and crop tops are not allowed.
 - Compliance with the dress code is essential, and delegates found in violation may not be allowed to take part in the conference.

DECORUM

Decorum must be maintained throughout the conference.

- Use of inappropriate language and disrespect towards co-delegates, the Executive Board, the press or logistics members will not be tolerated. Strict action will be taken against delegates guilty of disrespectful demeanour and language.
- Punctuality is a must. Tardiness may result in missing important information or parts of committee proceedings. If you know in advance that you will be unable to attend a session on time, you should inform your Executive Board of the same.
- Use of devices (whether connected to the internet or not) when the committee is in session is prohibited unless explicitly authorised by the Executive Board.
- Videography and/or photography of anything and/or anyone on the school's campus is not allowed at any time. In the event of a suspected offence, you may be asked to demonstrate to a member of the Secretariat that offending footage (if any) has been deleted from your device. Offenders may not be allowed to continue participating in the conference.
- Not following the above norms will result in strict disciplinary action being taken against the delegate.

By adhering to the schedule, dress code, and conduct guidelines, we can ensure a smooth, respectful, and enriching experience for all.
